

Have a look at the video promoting Mszana and Budišova nad Budišovkou!

Over 200-year-old massive linden, a natural monument in Polomia, the renovated building of the old parish, or the Common Grave of the Victims of the Death March in Mszana where a lot of tourists, even from Israel, come every year – those are only some of the tourist attractions in the Community of Mszana. There is also a lot to visit in our twin town in the Czech Republic - Budišova nad Budišovkou, among others: the Museum of Slate, the Monumental Bridge with the Statue of St. Nepomucen, or the Church of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary consecrated in 1756. There are also an autocamping where you can stay for a short holiday, as well as a lot of picturesque bicycle paths.

All the mentioned attractions, as well as many others, are presented in the promotional video prepared by the twin communities within the project *LET'S MEET YOURS AND OURS*. You can watch the video online, on January 15th the movie was promoted among local community of Mszana and the guests from the Czech Republic, the governor Rostislav Kyncl and his deputy Patrik Schramm were among the most important visitors.

The Centre of Culture and Recreation in Mszana was the place where the managers and headmasters of cultural, educational and sports institutions gathered together with the representatives of different associations and organizations, sports clubs and informal groups which take an active part in the Community life. There was also a tour guide present.

- Although the Community of Mszana is not a typical tourist place, you can do a lot of interesting things here and spend time actively. Also the twin town Budišova nad Budišovkou has a lot of attractions which can be interesting to all visitors. When watching the video one can learn about the tourist attractions and all the major events to which everyone is invited – says the Mayor of Mszana, Mirosław Szymanek. – For obvious reasons – most of all, the limited time and the priorities of the project – we were not able to present all of our communities' features of social life in which local people take part actively. Therefore, this meeting is only the beginning of future collaboration directly among the citizens – he added.

The film was created in three languages: Polish, Czech and English. Its aim is to promote both of the twin communities, you can watch it on the websites of our offices and institutions, as well as when you enter youtube. Thanks to that, it will be accessible to all of those who are interested in so called 'weekend tourism.'

In Budišova nad Budišovkou the promotional event of the movie will be on 29 January. The final step, planned for early spring when the tourist season begins, will be promoting the film in local media.

The project is realised on the basis of the Cross-Border Co-operation Programme within Micro-funding, it is financed by European Regional Development Fund and from local budget 'Crossing the Borders.' The value of the project is 40 173 zloty, the European Union funding is 85%, the Government Budget – 10%, local budget – 5%. The film cost 15 thousand zloty.

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
