

DISTRICT COMPETITION OF POLISH LANGUAGE FOR PRIMARY SCHOOLS

On 16 April the District Competition of Polish Language for Primary Schools was organized in our school. 24 students from schools in our district took part in the competition. They had to pass the qualifying test at their schools to enter the district competition. Our school was represented by Patrycja Powieśnik, 6th Grade student, she was supervised by Mrs. Monika Kowalska, her Polish teacher, when preparing for the test. The final test aimed at checking students' knowledge of Polish linguistics and literature. The range of required skills included syntax and phonetics.
